Other places to visit/see.....

- Mt Brown 5 hour walk - medium rating. 30 kms south of Quorn.
- Ride to the stunningly beautiful Warren Gorge - recently sealed road. 21kms north of Quorn. A haven for kangaroos, echidnas, lizards & birds. Excellent views over forests, reservoir & bushland. 4 walks including part of Heysen Trail, but most are very steep & challenging. Suggestion - Walking Trail - 5.2 km circuit, can take dogs.
